All Early Learning-5 brought to and picked up from school by parents use the main doors at the front of the building.

To use the drive thru lane drivers enter the front driveway from the west end of the Administration building and proceed all the way to the front alongside the sidewalk. Students should exit or enter the car on the sidewalk side only. Please do not double park, leave your car, block crosswalks or driveways and please leave as soon as your child has exited/entered the car to keep traffic flowing by **TURNING ONLY RIGHT ONTO 171st STREET.**

For student safety reasons only buses are allowed in the circle drive behind the building.

If a parent wants to park, there are designated spots in the front of the building, or one can park on 171st street.

Drop-Off & Pick-Up Procedures

Car Riders: Vehicles enter west from Hemlock Drive and turn right into the CAR RIDER LANE. Students load and unload from the sidewalk-side only, entering through Door 2. All vehicles exit this lot- **RIGHT TURN ONLY**- onto Hemlock Drive.

Walkers: First through fifth grade students enter/exit through the west entrance, Door A12. Kindergarten students enter/exit on the west side of the building, using Doors A9 or B4. .

Bus riders: Buses use the west lot sidewalk for loading and unloading students-curb side only. Exiting this lot is a **LEFT TURN ONLY**. Students enter/exit the west side of the building using Door B6.

Every child, on a daily basis, should know if they are a "car rider," "bus rider," or "walker."

Drop-Off & Pick-Up Procedures

Student drop-off and pick-up is in the WEST Lot. This is for all students arriving by vehicle. Please place the pink family name card in the passenger side of the front window. It is crucial that any vehicle used to pick up a student has a family name card.

Early Learning/Kindergarten/Grade 1

Please use the large circular drive to access Door 5. Staff will assist with unloading and loading early learning and kindergarten students. Upon arrival, staff will walk students inside the building and to their class rooms.

Grades 2-5

Please use the short turn around to access Door 10. Students are expected to exit and enter vehicles independently.

Please do not leave your vehicle unattended. Proceed forward once the vehicle in front of yours moves. Upon exiting the lot, only a **RIGHT TURN** is permitted. All cell phone use is prohibited in the school parking lot.

Bus Riders

Only buses are allowed in the bus lane during arrival and dismissal times. As students are dismissed from the buses, they are to go inside the building through Door 1 and to their lockers.

Make-Up Work When Absent

If a student is absent, missed assignments can be requested. If requesting over the phone, we ask that you do so by noon to allow time to prepare assignments and materials. Students will be given the same number of days as the absence to complete missed assignments and tests.
