Elements of Design

Skill:

- Identify and use the primary colors of: red, yellow, and blue and the secondary colors of: orange, violet and green
- Identify and use geometric and organic shapes
- Identify and use horizontal line as horizon line
- Identify texture in a variety of media
- Identify and use foreground and background
- Identify and use three-dimensional forms: cube, cylinder, sphere, pyramid and cone

Performance:

- Create a Color Wheel of six colors that includes the primary and secondary colors
- Categorize shapes according to geometric and organic
- Create a landscape featuring a horizon line
- Create various textures through rubbings
- Identify foreground and background in a landscape
- Use clay to create three-dimensional forms
